

CONCORD AMERICAN LITTLE LEAGUE **VOLUNTEER SERVICE POLICY**

Each family of the Concord American Little League is expected to participate in the programs of the league, including performing volunteer service. The following rules will govern the volunteer service requirements for the 2011 season.

1. Volunteer Service Fee: At the time of registration, each family will pay an \$80.00 volunteer service fee (or \$50.00 for T-Ball & Coach Pitch) as a "deposit" against their future volunteer work. The League will collect and retain this fee until the service requirement for that family is met, as outlined in this document.

2. Amount of Required Service: Each family is expected to perform volunteer work that has a minimum total count of at least 10 POINTS as defined in the list of jobs below.

3. Rainout Policy: If ALL games for that day are cancelled, the stand will be closed. Since most rainouts occur early in the season, you will have the remainder of the season to fulfill your volunteer requirement. Special arrangements can be made to work another time if you cannot work any of your teams scheduled assignments. If nothing is available, post season slots are available.

4. Record Keeping: As volunteer work is completed, each family will have it recorded on their "scorecard" with verification by the League Official in charge of the event.

5. Refund of Fee: Once a family has a completed scorecard showing that they have completed the required 10 points of credit; the card must be delivered to the League by mail to the CALL address indicated on the form. If properly completed, the volunteer fee will be refunded by mail. NOTE: Refunds will not be rolled over.

6. Processing of Refund – Scorecards properly submitted by a family with the required points will be processed. Checks will be issued in the month of September. Any forms submitted after 7/31/2011 will not be accepted.

7. Credit of refund: Families will have the option of rolling fees over to pay for 2011 All-stars team or Fall Ball league.

Volunteer Jobs and Points of Credit

Listed below are the volunteer positions that the League needs to fill. Next to each job is the point value one can claim when performing the job. 10 points are required to receive your \$80 volunteer service fee refund.

**Note: Families with only one (1) T-Ball or Coach Pitch 8 points are required for \$50 refund.

Manager or official coach: 10 points

Home Plate Umpire: 3 points per game

Base Umpire: 2 point per game

Scorekeeper: 2 points per game

Field Maintenance workday: 3 points per day

Team Mom (1 per team): 10 points - (If two team moms, each team mom will receive 5 points.)

Post-season Tournament Director: 4 points

Post-season Tournament Snack Shack Volunteer: 2 points per game

Family-Opening Day Volunteer (2 hours min) 2 points

Snack Shack Worker 2 points per game

Solicitor of Sponsors - \$500 level 3 points per sponsor

League Sponsor -- \$1000 level 5 points
